- Q. (By Mr. Klyman) As you were saying, when you got there to the scene at 46 Burr Street, you took a woman who turned out to be Karen Fuller into custody; is that right?
- 6 | A. Yes.

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- 7 Q. And you had her in the back of your patrol car; is that 8 right?
- 9 A. Yes.
- Q. And during that period of time you questioned her or she said to you various things to you about why it is that she was there, isn't that right?
- 13 A. Yes.
- Q. She told you she was sent there by her boyfriend Trevin
 Smith, isn't that right?
- 16 A. Yes.
- Q. And that Trevin Smith, she reported to you, was, well, armed with more than one firearm, isn't that right?
- 19 A. Yes.
- Q. And upon receiving that information, you broadcast that over the police radio, isn't that correct?
- 22 A. I don't remember if I broadcast it or told my 23 lieutenant that or -- I'm not sure.
- Q. Well, the purpose -- the thing is that you did relay that information to other authorities, isn't that correct?
